

ORDERS ON MEMO

The counsel for defendants has filed a memo stating the name of the private handwriting expert by name Phaneendra B.N. The counsel for the plaintiff submitted that the documents may be sent to a government expert instead of the private handwriting expert.

This court by its order dated 26.03.2016 allowed I.A. No.VI filed by the defendants for appointment

of a commissioner for scientific investigation. The defendant has now proposed the name of the private handwriting expert.

It appears that the forensic science laboratory, Bengaluru is overburdened with work. It may take more than six months or one year to the government department to submit its report with respect to handwriting.

I feel that in the facts and circumstances of the case, if a private person is appointed, he may be in a position to submit the report early. Therefore, the objections raised by the counsel for the plaintiff are overruled and proceed to pass the following:
